

THE SIXTEEN PROPHECIES ABOUT ISRAEL

There are 16 prophecies that were made for the Nation of Israel, they are: Gen. 15:13-14, 18-20, Deut 22:15-21, 12:5-6, Amos 5:27, 6:14, 7:17, Jer. 16:13, 21:10, 2Chr. 7:19-22, Isa. 6:11-13, 21:10, Matt. 24:2, Luke 19:43-44, Lev. 26:33-34, 36-39, Ezek. 12:13, Isa. 11:11-12, Zech. 10:9-10; 12:10-14; 14:3-5.

These first 13 prophecies have been completed. The prophecy in Zech. 12:2-33 about Jews returning to Israel is happening now, which only leaves 2 prophecies to come.



The next prophetic thing that will happen to the Jewish people in the land of Israel is as follows: **Zech. 12:10-14** *“And I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him, like the bitter weeping over a first-born. “In that day there will be great mourning in Jerusalem, like the mourning of Hadadrimmon in the plain of Megiddo. “And the land will mourn, every family by itself; the family of the house of David by itself, and their wives by themselves; the family of the house of Nathan by itself, and their wives by themselves; the family of the house of Levi by itself, and their wives by themselves; the family of the Shimeites by itself, and their wives by themselves; all the families that remain, every family by itself, and their wives by themselves.”* The final prophecy that is yet to very soon come is found in **Zech. 14:3-5** *“Then Elohim will go forth and fight against those nations, as when He fights on a day of battle. And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, which is in front of Jerusalem on the east; and the Mount of Olives will be split in its middle from east to west by a very large valley, so that half of the mountain will move toward the north and the other half toward the south. And you will flee by the valley of My mountains, for the valley of the mountains will reach to Azel; yes, you will flee just as you fled before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then Elohim, my Yah, will come, {and} all the holy ones with Him!”* It is safe to say that if 14 of the 16 prophecies have happened, Yah is keeping His word, and the last 2 are not far away. Yahveh cannot lie!
