

YESHUA SEPARATING THE SHEEP AND THE GOATS (Matt. 25:31-33)

Matt. 25:31-33 *“But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. “And all the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; and **He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left.**”*



In order to fully appreciate these verses we must first go back to their origin as a prophecy in Ezekiel. In the prophecy Ezekiel talks about the preachers, teachers who claim to work for the Almighty, but do not. He talks about exactly what we have seen going on in the SUNDAY type so-called christian churches for centuries. These CEO'S will pay dearly for fleecing the flock of the Most High some day when they face Yeshua. **Ezek. 34:1-10** *Then the word of the LORD came to me saying, 2 “Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel. Prophesy and say to those shepherds, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD, “**Woe, shepherds of Israel who have been feeding themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flock?** 3 “You eat the fat and clothe yourselves with the wool, you slaughter the fat sheep without feeding the flock. 4 “Those who are sickly you have not strengthened, the diseased you have not healed, the broken you have not bound up, the scattered you have not brought back, nor have you sought for the lost; but with force and*

*with severity you have dominated them. 5 “And they were scattered for lack of a shepherd, and they became food for every beast of the field and were scattered. 6 “**My flock wandered through all the mountains and on every high hill, and My flock was scattered over all the surface of the earth; and there was no one to search or seek for them.**” 7 Therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of the LORD: 8 “As I live,” declares the Lord GOD, “surely because My flock has become a prey, My flock has even become food for all the beasts of the field for lack of a shepherd, and My shepherds did not search for My flock, but rather the shepherds fed themselves and did not feed My flock; 9 therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of the LORD: 10 ‘Thus says the Lord GOD, “Behold, I am against the shepherds, and I shall demand My sheep from them and make them cease from feeding sheep. So the shepherds will not feed themselves anymore, but I shall deliver My flock from their mouth, that they may not be food for them.””*

Ezek. 34:11-16 *For thus says the Lord GOD, “Behold, I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out. 12 “As a shepherd cares for his herd in the day when he is among his scattered sheep, so I will care for My sheep and will deliver them from all the places to which they were scattered on a cloudy and gloomy day. 13 “And I will bring them out from the peoples and gather them from the countries and bring them to their own land; and I will feed them on the mountains of Israel, by the streams, and in all the inhabited places of the land. 14 “I will feed them in a good pasture, and their grazing ground will be on the mountain heights of Israel. There they will lie down in good grazing ground, and they will*

feed in rich pasture on the mountains of Israel. 15 **“I will feed My flock and I will lead them to rest,” declares the Lord GOD.** 16 **“I will seek the lost, bring back the scattered, bind up the broken, and strengthen the sick; but the fat and the strong I will destroy. I will feed them with judgement.**

Ezek. 34:17-19 **“And as for you, My flock, thus says the Lord GOD, ‘Behold, I will judge between one sheep and another, between the rams and the male goats. 18 ‘Is it too slight a thing for you that you should feed in the good pasture, that you must tread down with your feet the rest of your pastures? Or that you should drink of the clear waters, that you must foul the rest with your feet? 19 ‘And as for My flock, they must eat what you tread down with your feet, and they must drink what you foul with your feet!’”**

Ezek. 34:20-24 **Therefore, thus says the Lord GOD to them, “Behold, I, even I, will judge between the fat sheep and the lean sheep. 21 “Because you push with side and with shoulder, and thrust at all the weak with your horns, until you have scattered them abroad, 22 therefore, I will deliver My flock, and they will no longer be a prey; and I will judge between one sheep and another. 23 “Then I will set over them one shepherd, My servant David, and he will feed them; he will feed them himself and be their shepherd. 24 “And I, the LORD, will be their God, and My servant David will be prince among them; I, the LORD, have spoken.**

Ezek. 34:25-31 **“And I will make a covenant of peace with them and eliminate harmful beasts from the land, so that they may live securely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods. 26 “And I will make them and the places around My hill a blessing. And I will cause showers to come down in their season; they will be showers of blessing. 27 “Also the tree of the field will yield its fruit, and the earth will yield its increase, and they will be secure on their land. Then they will know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bars of their yoke and have delivered them from the hand of those who enslaved them. 28 “And they will no longer be a prey to the nations, and the beasts of the earth will not devour them; but they will live securely, and no one will make them afraid. 29 “And I will establish for them a renowned planting place, and they will not again be victims of famine in the land, and they will not endure the insults of the nations anymore. 30 “Then they will know that I, the LORD their God, am with them, and that they, the house of Israel, are My people,” declares the Lord GOD. 31 “As for you, My sheep, the sheep of My pasture, you are men, and I am your God,” declares the Lord GOD.”**

When you have a large flock of sheep and goats it is very hard to distinguish one from the other unless you look closely, especially from a distance. The goats are always bullying the sheep around. They tend to push and shove wherever they are in the herd. They don't guide the others, they simply butt them around with their horns. This butting around, dominating, manipulating, controlling of others in the flock is symbolic of witchcraft. That is exactly what has been going on in the pro-claimed churches since the beginning of time. In almost all cases witchcraft, used directly or indirectly, has been used to control, dominate, and manipulate the sheep and the MONEY of the flock. That is why in most churches every third or fourth sermon is about tithing. They are bound and determined to get control of the money of the congregation so they can do with it as they see fit.

The Bible speaks about a time when the righteous will be separated from the

wicked. In Rev.14:15 we read about Exodus Part Two when Yeshua reaps the harvest of the earth. **Rev. 14:15** *And another angel came out of the temple, crying out with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, "Put in your sickle and reap, because the hour to reap has come, because **the harvest of the earth is ripe.**"* **Matt. 13:49** says, "So it will be at the close of the age, **the angels will go forth and separate the evil people from among the righteous.**" Messiah must first gather His redeemed righteous community before Yah pours out His wrath on the earth. Other similar illustrations compare sheep and goats, wheat and chaff.

SUMMARY

I have probably got carried away here, off the beaten path a little bit, but this message of exposing false prophets needs to be heard so please bear with me as I summarize. The false prophets of the pagan churches, calling themselves the anointed ones; preachers, teachers, evangelists and pastors, will soon meet the Master Rabbi Yeshua face to face for their judgement. Their judgement will most likely include being sent to the Lake of Fire. These wolves in shepherds clothing calling themselves the spirit filled anointed ones will be punished far more severe than the other deceivers that work for Satan, because they have done their evil works under the auspices of the body of Messiah. These snakes preaching from the pulpits on SUNday's will soon pay for their works of darkness.

Those who eventually see the paganism of these Babylonian churches and flee are called the remnant. That remnant learn the Hebraic roots of the Hebrew bible and leave Babylon. This is now happening across the globe. Those who remain in these pagan palaces will soon realize, when their pockets are empty, that they too have been deceived over all these years simply because they were too lazy to read the bible themselves and check things out. They will soon realize that these pro-claimed christian churches are and have always been, under the influence of Rome, businesses disguised as the church. Truly the darkness of these dead pagan palaces is the only thing coming to life in them.

There are many scriptures describing these false clergy, especially written by the suffering servant Jeremiah. Let's have a look at some of them to get a glimpse of what Yah says about them through his great prophet Jeremiah and exactly what He has in store for them.

Jer. 5:30-31 *"An appalling and horrible thing Has happened in the land: **The prophets prophesy falsely,** And the priests rule on their {own} authority; And My people love it so! But what will you do at the end of it?"*

Jer. 6:13 *"For from the least of them even to the greatest of them, **Everyone is greedy for gain,** And from the prophet even to the priest Everyone deals falsely."*

Jer. 7:11 *"Has this house, which is called by My name, become **a den of robbers** in your sight? Behold, I, even I, have seen {it,}" declares Elohim."*

Jer. 10:21 *"For **the shepherds have become stupid** And have not sought Elohim; Therefore they have not prospered, And all their flock is scattered."*

Jer. 10:21 ***For the pastors are become brutish,** and have not sought Elohim: therefore they shall not prosper, and all their flocks shall be scattered." (KJV)*

Jer. 12:10-11 *"**Many shepherds have ruined My vineyard,** They have trampled down My field; They have made My pleasant field A desolate wilderness. "It has been made a*

desolation, Desolate, it mourns before Me; The whole land has been made desolate, Because no man lays it to heart."

Jer. 12:10-11 *"**Many pastors have destroyed my vineyard, they have trodden my portion under foot, they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness. They have made it desolate, and being desolate it mourneth unto me; the whole land is made desolate, because no man layeth it to heart.**" (KJV)*

Jer. 48:10 *"**Cursed be the one who does Yahveh's work negligently, And cursed be the one who restrains his sword from blood.**"*

To wind it all up I will again let the scriptures do the talking.

Zech. 10:2 *"For the teraphim speak iniquity, And the diviners see lying visions, And tell false dreams; They comfort in vain. Therefore {the people} wander like sheep, They are afflicted, because **there is no shepherd.**"*

Next time you turn on your television and see preachers, teachers, and supposed leaders anointed to do the ministry of the King of Kings, ask yourself if what they are DOING and SPEAKING lines up with the ACTUAL WRITTEN Word of the Almighty. Test what they say against the REAL Word and decide for yourself which team they are one. There are only two teams, you are either with Yah or against Him. No one walks the fence.
