

## TO BE HOLY IS TO OBEY, TO BE SET-APART

1Pet. 1:15-16 *"but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all {your} behavior; because it is written, **"YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."***

This is another very commonly referred to verse that people use in reference to Yah's people *"be holy for I am holy"*. When Peter is talking here he is repeating what is written in the torah, found in Lev. 11:45 and Lev. 19:1-2. **Lev. 11:45** *For I am the Lord who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God; thus **you shall be holy, for I am holy.***" He is simply saying that holy people are set apart because of many things they do and one of the many things that sets them apart from the heathens is eating clean food. **Lev. 19:1-2** *Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: 2 "Speak to all the congregation of the sons of Israel and say to them, '**You shall be holy, for I the Lord your God am holy.**'" (Also Lev. 20:7)*
