

## ONLY A DOG RETURNS TO ITS VOMIT

2Pet. 2:22 *"It has happened to them according to the true proverb, "A dog returns to its own vomit," and, "A sow, after washing, returns to wallowing in the mire."*



Peter was talking about so-called believers that had known and experienced some truth. "Dog" here refers to those who were once Gentiles (pagans) who proclaimed to be Believers, turning back to their old ways, not obeying Yah's Torah. "Vomit" refers to the old pagan ways that they carried into their so-called Christianity. They simply changed the names of the pagan holidays and traditions and claimed they were then biblical.
