

Deut. 15:7-8 LENDING MONEY TO THE POOR



Deut. 15:7-8 *"If there is a poor man with you, **one of your brothers**, in any of your towns in your land which the LORD your God is giving you, you shall not harden your heart, nor close your hand from your poor brother; 8 but you shall freely open your hand to him, and shall generously **lend him sufficient** for his need in whatever he lacks."*

This is referring to lending money to your brethren, (the household of the faithful), like minded Believers, not the general public. When all your brethren are looked after, then those in the general public who need to borrow money, should also be helped. This is known as humanitarian aid.
