

FOLLOW ME

Matt. 4:18-19 *“Now as Yeshua was walking by the Sea of Galilee, He saw **two brothers**, Simon who was called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. And He said to them, (written in red) **“Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.”**”*

The first four disciples Yeshua chose, (Peter, Andrew, James and John), were fishermen (notice also they did not volunteer). As most people understand, fisherman are fanatics. Fisherman will sit very patiently for hours on end waiting for a bite. They are extremely patient and enduring. They are also willing and able to sit through many storms and crazy weather conditions in order to catch what they are pursuing. We should also notice that two fishermen were throwing the nets and two were mending the nets. This too is symbolic of the apostolic way of doing things: proclaiming the Word to the lost sheep, and making sure the nets are maintained and in good condition, (teaching the truth to the sheep). The fishermen worked in unity (echad). Today's churches are casting nets with holes in them. “Follow me” was the same as Yeshua said, as a Rabbi, (“come”, in Matt. 14:29, John 6:19-20 (see John 6:19-20, Matt. 14:29). Also look at Luke 9:57-62.
