

## DEPART FROM ME YOU LAWLESS ONES!

Matt. 7:21-23 “(written in red) **Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven; but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven.** “Many will say to Me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, **did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?’** “And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; **DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.**’



Besides the obvious meaning here about people using Adonai's name in vain and because of it, not going to heaven, there are other deeper meanings that must be considered. Here Yeshua was talking about people who call on Adonai of Mercy (Yahveh) but don't want to know about the Yahveh of Justice (Elohim) and don't want to obey His commandments. It says: depart from me, you who practice lawlessness”, this part makes it clear about those people who don't follow Yahveh's laws/instructions. Not following His instructions (law) is SIN, as per **1John 3:4 “sin is lawlessness”**, and those who SIN are of the devil, as per **1John 3:8 “the one who practices sin is of the devil”**. Another important understanding of this scripture is in regards to the Kingship of Yah. He is our Lord-King only to the extent that we make ourselves His subjects. That is why Yeshua says **“why do you call me Lord, Lord and do not what I say”**. Put these verses together with **Rom. 6:23 “the wages of sin is death”**, and you have an indisputable example of why the laws of Abba are so important in our daily lives.

Another serious point of interest here is the part that says: **“did we not in your name ---cast out demons”**. Many claim to represent Yahveh, but few do. Many claim to cast out devils in His name, but those who claim this are in many cases simply liars. NO ONE can cast out demons unless they have the authority in the NAME of Yahveh and Yeshua. They

must be born again and anointed to do so in most cases. Few so-called christians are born again, so that eliminates them. This narrows down the field dramatically, simply because about 99.99% of so-called Christians have demons and are NOT born again.

In this verse it is asking a question; "did we?", and obviously Yeshua knew they were mocking Him, so He answered likewise: "DEPART FROM ME," There are many charlatans out there in the Christian world who entertain people by manipulating demons by means of witchcraft and soul power that Yeshua is talking about here. These charlatans move demons around, but never actually cast them out, because they are not holy, and don't have the anointing required to do so. Some of these false prophets may appear to be casting out demons, but the reality is, the demons are just entertaining people who don't know better. These demons may appear to leave, but are coming back in, because they have a legal right to be there. These people without His authority have no legal right to cast them out. Not everyone who calls Him King (Lord, Lord), is obeying His orders, so why bother claiming that He is your King-Lord if you are not following His laws (Torah). Talk is cheap!
