

## Hebr. 10:24-26 DON'T FORSAKE THE ASSEMBLING OF THE PEOPLE

*“and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own **assembling together**, as is the habit of some, but encouraging [one another]; and all the more as you see the day drawing near. For if we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,”*



The "assembling together" part of this passage has been used by the SUNday preachers (CEO'S), for years to promote people to be part of their fellowship. They have no idea what it means, so they preach fellowship so they can receive more buckets of money during their business services. If you can convince lonely lazy people to come to your fellowship meetings every Sunday, it is no doubt good for the books.

In verse 24 it is not talking about church fellowship as most are lead to believe. It is talking about the assembling of the people three times a year for the Feasts Of Yahveh. It was even commanded that the men assemble together in Jerusalem for these three special occasions. What is being revealed in verse 26 is as follows: In the early years of the Temple you could literally sin as much as you wanted if you didn't truly follow Adonai, and still daily offer up a sacrifice to cover that sin, whatever it may be. Now that Yeshua died on the stake for our sins we can't offer up sacrifices to cover our sin. We are to repent of the sin and change our ways, or we are not following Yahveh in spirit and in truth. This is not to say that Yahveh will not ever forgive us, but it means that we must repent of such a sin and stop doing it. As long as we can come before the throne of His grace and mercy and repent, He is willing to forgive and pardon us. If we refuse to repent

(change), then we simply lose whatever rights we previously had as a Believer. This includes our salvation.
