

YESHUA HEALS A LEPER

Mark 1:40-45 *And a leper came to Yeshua, beseeching Him and falling on his knees before Him, and saying, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." Moved with compassion, Yeshua stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." (42) **Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed.** And He sternly warned him and immediately sent him away, and He said to him, (44) (written in red) See that you say nothing to anyone; but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, as a testimony to them." But he went out and began to proclaim it freely and to spread the news around, to such an extent that Yeshua could no longer publicly enter a city, but stayed out in unpopulated areas; and they were coming to Him from everywhere.*

It was taught for centuries before Yeshua came, that there were four miracles that only the coming Messiah could do. In these verses we see **Yeshua healing a leper** which was a sign of the coming Messiah. The true Messiah was the only person that would be able to heal a leper (Mark 1:40-45). The true Messiah was the only person that would be able to cast out a mute demon (Matt. 12:22-23). The true Messiah was the only person that would be able to heal a man who was blind from birth (John 9:1-7). The true Messiah was the only person that would be able to raise a man from the dead (John 11:1-44). Yeshua knew about this teaching of the four miracles, so when He told John to tell the people what John had seen, He was indirectly showing the people who He really was.
