## 1Cor. 2:15 ONE WHO IS SPIRIT APPRAISES ALL THINGS

**1Cor. 2:15** But he who is spiritual appraises all things, yet he himself is appraised by no man. The "spiritual man" is the man who's spirit dominates his soulish desires. The spiritual man is the man who is sensitive to his intuition, which is communion with El Gibor. That intuition quietly performs its function not bothered by emotions, will, intellect, and the mind of the soul. Intuition is not an energy as many want to experience, but rather an inner need to do as lead without even fully understanding why. This is the spiritual man. This is the man that no one can judge because no one knows what his intuition imparts on him via the holy spirit. His knowledge is dependent on the holy spirit, which manifests as inner intuition and conscience.



Psalm 28:4 – Requite them according to their work and according to the evil of their practices; Requite them according to the deeds of their hands; Repay them their recompense.

Psalm 62:12 – And lovingkindness is Yours, O Lord, for You recompense a man according to his work.

Proverbs 12:14 – A man will be satisfied with good by the fruit of his words, and the deeds of a man's hands will return to him.

Proverbs 24:12 – If you say, "See, we did not know this," does He not consider it who weighs the hearts and does He not know it who keeps your soul? And will He not render to man according to his work?

Ecclesiastes 12:14 – For God will bring every act to judgment, everything which is hidden, whether it is good or evil.

Isaiah 59:18 – According to their deeds, so He will repay, wrath to His adversaries, recompense to His enemies; to the coastlands He will make recompense.

Jeremiah 17:10 – "I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind, even to give to each man according to his ways, according to the results of his deeds.

Jeremiah 25:14 – (For many nations and great kings will make slaves of them, even them; and I will recompense them according to their deeds and according to the work of their hands.)

Lamentations 3:64 – You will recompense them, O Lord, according to the work of their hands.

Ezekiel 7:27 – The king will mourn, the prince will be clothed with horror, and the hands of the people of the land will tremble. according to their conduct I will deal with them, and by their judgments I will judge them. And they will know that I am the Lord.

Ezekiel 24:14 – I, the Lord, have spoken; it is coming and I will act. I will not relent, and I will not pity and I will not be sorry; according to your ways and according to your deeds I will judge you," declares the Lord God."

John 5:29 – and will come forth; those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil deeds to a resurrection of judgment.

1 Corinthians 3:8 – Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but each will receive his own reward according to his own labor.

2 Corinthians 5:10 – For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

Revelation 20:12 – And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.

Revelation 20:13 – And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds.

Revelation 22:12 – Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done.

If man would follow his intuition and be spirit filled he would be lead by the Ruach Ha Kodesh. Without this infilling of His Spirit our intuition has no control over our fleshly desires and we sin continuously. We all

have intuition available to us but too often don't take heed. That intuition shows us which way to go and how to get there but our soulish desires interfere because we are naturally lead by our five senses, our flesh.

Truly spiritual Believers are not to allow their soul to lead them, even though the soul is very capable of manifesting emotions, thoughts, ideas, etc. There is knowledge available through the soul, its latent power is incredible, but it is NOT the SOUL that Yah told us to be lead by.
