## SCAPEGOAT..THROW HIM DOWN THE CLIFF

Luke 4:28-30 "And all [the people] in the synagogue were filled with rage as they heard these things; and they got up and drove Him out of the city, and led Him to the brow of the hill on which their city had been built, **in order to throw Him down the cliff.** But passing through their midst, He went His way."

If you recall during the Feast of Atonement the Priest led the scapegoat (which had been used to cover the sins of the Nation), into the desert and pushed it backwards off a cliff to its death. The people didn't realize that by doing this they were also making what was rehearsed in the Feast of Passover for many years, manifest. In a way, Yeshua was the scapegoat that all the sins of the world had been cast upon and sent out to die. DASYD Ministry
