

“HAIL MARY” PRAYER

“Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of death. Amen”

In Catholicism this Hail Mary prayer is repeated sometimes for hours for those who want to repent. This repetition we were warned about in **Acts 19:34** “But when they recognized that he was a Jew, a {single} outcry arose from them all as they shouted for about two hours, “Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!” Artemis was the goddess Diana. **Matt. 6:7** “And when you are praying, **do not use meaningless repetition, as the Gentiles do, for they suppose that they will be heard for their many words.**”

In reciting the complete Catholic Rosary, the “Hail Mary” prayer is repeated 53 times, this is nine times as often as the “Lord’s Prayer”. Not only do they honor the Queen of Heaven, the Mother Mary of the Catholic church, but they also honor "Amen" the "Hidden god".

According to a venerable tradition, the devotion of the so called "holy Rosary" was revealed to St. Dominic by the blessed Virgin Mary, and he used it as a powerful talisman (amulet, charm, fetish, weapon) against the so called heresy of Albigenses in the end of the 12th or 13th century. St. Dominic, a native of Calaroga in Old Castile, Spain, was of the illustrious house of the Guzmans.



PRAYING THE ROSARY CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING

- 1) Make the sign of the upside down cross and say the "Apostles Creed".
- 2) Say the "Our Father who art in Heaven prayer".
- 3) Say the "Hail Mary Prayer" three times.

- 4) Say the "Glory be to the Father prayer" once.
- 5) Announce the first mystery; then say the "our Father prayer".
- 6) Say ten "Hail Mary's", while meditating on the mystery.
- 7) Say the "Glory be to the Father" and "Fatima Prayer".
- 8) Announce the second mystery; then say the "Our Father prayer".

Repeat and continue with third, fourth, and fifth mysteries in the same manner.

After all five decades, say the "Hail Holy Queen" and the concluding prayer.

Praying the Rosary is far from holy, it is clearly a pagan thing to do. The Greek's have their worry beads to finger, other religions have what is called a prayer wheel, and the Roman Catholics have the Rosary. Did you ever ask yourself this question? "Who gets all the glory on those beads?" It's not God, He only gets one prayer, she gets 10 to His one. This is out of balance. This is not of YHVH, REPENT and listen to Yeshua's words in **Luke 11:27-28** *"And it came to pass, as Yeshua spoke these things, a certain woman of the company lifted up her voice, and said unto him, Blessed is the womb that bare thee, and the breasts which thou hast sucked. But Yeshua said, No! Rather blessed are they that hear the Word of YHVH, and keep it"*
