



HOW TO RECEIVE THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The following are **seven** conditions in the bible that are most often required to receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit:

1. Repent. (Acts 2:37-38)
2. Be baptized in water. (Acts 2:37-38) Can be done before or after.
3. Ask YHVH for it. (Luke 11:9-13)
4. Be thirsty for it. (John 7:37-39)
5. Come to Yeshua. (John 7:37-39)
6. Drink the spirit. (John 7:37-39)
7. Yield. Present your body as a temple for the Holy Spirit, and your members as instruments of righteousness. (Romans 6:13)



When a person gets baptized in the Holy Spirit they are supposed to drink in the breath of the Elohim's Ruach. When the Holy Spirit fills you to overflowing, then the overflow comes out as speaking in tongues.

Sometimes supernatural spiritual warfare involving curses and demons hinder people from receiving the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. If one has earnestly been trying to follow Yeshua and has not been able to receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit he must seriously consider "**deliverance**" and "**curse removal**". In fact all serious Believers should **FIRST** have deliverance, and go through formal curse removal so they are pure in their nature and soul. It is not possible to be lead by the spirit to any degree, if your soul has "demonic influences," or "curses" present, hindering your close walk with Yeshua. Whether you do "self deliverance of curses and demons", or ministry removal is not the question, as long as it's done.

Whatever the things to which we are bound are, Dad will deal with them one after another. Even such trivialities such as eating, drinking, clothing, etc., can not escape the careful hand of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will not neglect one area in our lives if we follow Adonai's discipline. Believers must be broken with discipline so that we can be delivered of the many things in our lives that we cannot take into eternity. Ha Shem knows, and will deal with all our needs. We will only

know liberty when the day comes that everything is destroyed. The Holy Spirit may deal with us through others, arranging certain things to happen, in certain order, by certain people, in certain places. He may even use our enemies, or people we are jealous of, or have little to do with, but it is never coincidence. We do not, and cannot understand how thoroughly the Holy Spirit works for us, but we can trust that what it is doing is for the benefit of all concerned.

We must **“VERBALLY”** ask for the forgiveness of our sins and ask Adonai to fill our heart with His Holy Spirit (Rom. 10:8).

The following are two suggested prayers that you may use while an appropriately anointed person lays hands on you for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT PRAYER

Before you attempt the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, make sure you have taken control of the situation you are in. Verbally cut off all communication with Satan, his principalities, powers and rulers. Then take authority over and bind all demon spirits that may be present. Especially bind the spirits of un-repentance and unforgiveness. Then declare the place you are at as “Holy Ground” (Acts 7:33), and dedicate it (even if just temporarily), to Adonai. Then invite the Holy Spirit into your midst, cover yourself with the precious blood of the lamb and continue with the following process.



You must give up the control of your tongue. After you have prayed for the Holy Spirit to come into your heart, you must stop talking so the Holy Spirit can take over your tongue. At this point you should open your mouth and try to speak gibberish, or words of any language that you don't know for a minute or two, (example Chinese, Polish, etc.), that usually helps open the door, so to speak, for the natural flow the Ruach will give you.

PRAYER #1

Dear Yahveh, Your scriptures say that" we receive not because we ask not". Father, we are here with You now, and we ask for the Baptism of Your Ruach Hakodesh.

We ask that You bless _____ with the Baptism Of Your Holy Spirit.

We ask that You give _____ the spiritual gifts and fruit of Your Holy Spirit.

_____ confesses all his/her sins to You now Father, he/her empties their heart for You. (allow a moments silence) *The recipient must **VERBALLY** ask YHVH for baptism of the Holy Spirit. He/she should repeat after you, the following:* Adonai, please forgive me for my sins. I now ask You to please fill my heart with Your Holy Spirit.

(Anoint them with oil, lay hands on them) Now; I ask that You fill my heart with Your Holy Spirit. Let it envelop all parts of my body, soul and spirit, so that I can become one with You. I “breath in” Your Holy Spirit, (take three deep breaths, in faith, and exhale). I submit myself to You Elohim so that You may do with me whatever You have planned. Give me now the many gifts of Your Spirit so that I can work with You and for You. I promise to always give You all the glory. I thank You now Father for the gift of Your Spirit. In Yeshua’s name I pray.

(If he/she is willing to do so in public) Now, in faith, I open my mouth Adonai, and speak the words that come from Your Spirit.

PRAYER #2

Yahveh, I'm thirsty for the fullness of Your Holy Spirit. I present my body to You as a Temple, and my members as instruments of righteousness, especially my tongue, the member of my body that I cannot tame

without your help. Fill me, I pray, and let Your Spirit flow through my lips in rivers of praise and worship. In Yeshua's name.

SUMMARY

When we receive Yeshua as Savior in our life, we receive the authority to become one of Adonai's children. The scriptures explain that YHVH has much more for us than authority. He has power available to us, for our lives. This power and authority is given to us so that we can become effective witnesses. When we are Baptized in the Holy Spirit we are empowered with supernatural gifts that must be used always with the "fear (respect) of YHVH" in mind. These gifts are not to be taken lightly for they are part of Elohim, Himself.

The Holy Spirit is represented by a dove, a dove is a very timid bird that scares quite easily, and flies away. This is what I believe happens in many churches today. The dove is scared away and the false prophet spirit replaces it, without people noticing the difference. The Holy Spirit will teach you all things.

John 14:26 "But the comforter, which is the Holy Spirit, whom the father will send in my name, **he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said to you**" The Holy Spirit cannot be used at will by anyone. Yahveh can not be used at will. He must be invited, and it is His decision to come or not, not mans decision. The Holy Spirit is to glorify Yah's Kingdom only. Everything connected with the Holy Spirit will always be Holy.

The Satanic imitator of the Holy Spirit is the "False Prophet". He constantly fools people with his supernatural ability to imitate the Holy Spirit. We must always beware of his presence, especially in our churches. The Holy Spirit is our intercessor

Rom. 8:26-27 "And in the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, **but the Spirit Himself intercedes for {us} with groanings too deep for words; and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to {the will of} YHVH.**"

When you know Elohim and He is your source, your success becomes unlimited.

Yeshua said "I am the vine and you are the branches", without me you can produce nothing, "with me nothing is impossible". When

Yah wants to create something, He takes a substance out of which He wants to create something, speaks to it, and out of that comes a substance. As long as that new creation stays in contact with that substance, it lives. When Yah created plants He spoke to the dirt, and out of the dirt came forth plants. As long as the plants stay in contact with the dirt, they live. Take a plant out of the dirt and it dies instantly. When Yah created fish, He planted them in the water, as long as fish stay in water they live. When Elohim created you, He created you out of Himself. He is your source, as long as you stay attached to Him and know Him, you have an eternal life, a spiritual vitality that nothing can destroy. Become detached from Him and spiritual death starts instantly. Knowing Yah is a matter of life and death! I repeat, knowing Yah is a matter of life and death! Yah said to Adam and Eve; "do not eat of the forbidden fruit for you shall surely die". When Adam and Eve ate of the forbidden fruit they died instantly spiritually. You must stay attached to Yah, He is the vine and you are the branches. Without Him you are nothing. If you know Him as your source, you have eternal life, you have vitality, you have peace, you have joy, you have assurance, you have confidence, you have power; because Yeshua is in you.

The point is; if you live life with Yah you can have a fulfilled life, an earnest life, with everything you need. The Bible says nothing is impossible to the true Believer, why? because your plugged into Adonai.

Eph. 3:20 says "Now to him who is able to do exceeding abundantly **beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to him be the glory in the church and in Messiah Yeshua to all generations forever and ever. Amen**". Think about how incredible this statement is, "**beyond all that we ask or think**". We are connected to Abba when we are in Him and there is no limit to what is available to us who truly believe and have faith in the power source of everything that exists. **Matt. 16:19** "I will give you the keys **of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.**" Now that's power, what could be more powerful than that? Nothing can be more powerful than that! In **John 15:7 Yeshua says "If you abide in me and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it shall be done for you."** If your top priority is to know and love Yah, then everything and anything you need and ask of Him shall be given, as long as it is guided by His Holy Spirit. If your spirit is guided by His Spirit then Satan has no legal right to come near you, as long as you stay out of his courtyard Satan cannot harm you. When knowing Yah is your top priority, all of life's major decisions



have already been made. Think about that statement **“When knowing Yahveh is your top priority, all of life’s major decisions have already been made.”** When you know Adonai, life is not complicated, it is quite simple, because all the big decisions are made by Dad according to your connection with Him. If you let Him direct you through your spirit, all will be well according to the amount that you let Him direct you. Your decisions have been made, and to some people that in itself can be difficult.

Two men decided to go fishing. They were life long friends and knew each other very well. One of them was a Game Warden. They were out on the lake and one man pulled out a sack; in the sack was a bunch of dynamite. The man pulled out some dynamite and the game warden said “what on earth are you doing?” The man said; “this is how I fish”. The game warden said if you do that I’ll have to arrest you. The man went ahead and lit one of the sticks of dynamite and tossed into the lap of the game warden. The game warden said “what on earth do you think you’re doing?” The other man said “did you come out here to talk or to fish?” It’s decision time. **Are you FOLLOWING YESHUA?**

Human nature being what it is; will force us to call on Yah. The Bible says: “you shall hear a voice behind you saying this is the way, walk in it.” If your the sheep and Yeshua is the shepherd, than if you hear a voice behind you saying **“this is the way, walk in it”** it means that you are in front of the shepherd! You need to get back behind the shepherd and let him lead you.

The leaders in the so-called churches today are not shepherds, and are simply not leading the sheep. They are, “the blind leading the blind”. Our leaders today should take a close look at what Sha’ul said when He was telling the priests how to preach and teach the Word of Yah according to Adonai, not according to church doctrine. **Titus 1:16-2:1** **“They profess to know Yahveh, but by {their} deeds they deny {Him}, being detestable and disobedient, and worthless for any good deed. But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine.”** Paul was telling them to teach sound doctrine from the Bible, not from the church catechism. More scriptures relating to the lack of Biblical teaching in our churches today can be found in **Mal. 2:7-9** **“For the lips of a priest should preserve knowledge, and men should seek instruction from his mouth; for he is the messenger of Adonai of hosts. “But as for you, you have turned aside from the way; you have caused many to stumble by the instruction; you have corrupted the covenant of Levi,” says Adonai of hosts. “So I also have made you despised and abased before all the people, just as you are not keeping My ways, but are showing partiality in the instruction.”** “Partiality in the instruction” means the ministers are not telling the Biblical truth, but instead substituting it with church doctrine, man made, rules, and pagan rituals, customs and instructions. They are selling religion as a business.

It is the duty and privilege of us as Believers today to act like Believers and not fit in with this world. Our God is a Holy God, and He told us to be likewise Holy in all that we are, and all that we do. **1Pet. 1:15-16** **“but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all {your} behavior; because it is written, “YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY.”** We are not to be easily fooled by the things of this world, we have a supernatural connection to Yahveh, and He promises to guide us if we put our trust in Him. We are not to sin intentionally, we are to strive for the truth of the word because we know the truth will set us free. We are not to be stagnant in our walk with Yahveh, we are to continually grow and mature. We are to avoid sin!

Those people who proclaim to be our leaders and get paid to do so had better do some serious thinking about the outcome of their action. **James 4:17** **“Therefore, to one who knows {the} right thing to do, and does not do it, to him it is sin.”** **Hebr. 10:26** **“For if we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,”** Not only is there no longer a sacrifice for pre-meditated sin and lawlessness, but it results in our spiritual death. **Rom. 6:23** **“For the wages of sin is death”** Spiritual death is not something that anyone wants. It is alienation from Yah, life without Adonai. No one in their right mind, who has received the fruits and gifts of the Holy Spirit, would ever want to consciously go backwards to a life without Yahveh. **Mal. 3:7b** **“Return to Me, and I will return to you,”**

For those who truly want and try to follow Abba, there are of course many advantages. The Baptism of the Holy Spirit is a major stepping stone to be looked forward to in the life of a Believer. It is hard to explain the depth of it. Being Baptized in the Holy Spirit is for most people a major event, “a particular time” that you will never forget. It is usually an “earth shaking” experience that will be remembered always. It is usually an event no Believer can be confused about, or forget. It is as unforgettable as the first time you made love, or your first girl or boy friend, or as unforgettable as the day you got married. In most cases, when it first happens, it is a **“divinely inspired high”** that goes on for months. Your eyes, ears, mind, and spirit are opened up for the first time (spiritually speaking), and comprehension, knowledge and wisdom, become within reach of your previously finite brain. A whole new world is opened up and you cannot stop searching for more knowledge and understanding of the “living word” of Yahveh (Adonai). You may have thought your “born again” experience was really something, and it probably was, but the reality is, it was like kinder-garden compared to the “graduation” you experience when baptized in the Holy Spirit. You find out that Yah has given you real weapons and real bullets for the spiritual war going on out there all around you. The war that you never even knew was going on before.



How much you receive from the Holy Spirit depends entirely on how much you are willing to give the Holy Spirit. If you “surrender all”, as you should, the following things will happen. Revelation of the word of Yah is given to you abundantly, and the Bible “comes alive”, the words come “right off” the page. You are not easily deceived. Your ability to discern makes it possible to tell the “wolves in shepherds clothing,” and the true Believers in YHVH the Father and His Son Yeshua. **The Ten Commandments** are not only written on your heart, but you gladly follow “**all of them**” as Yeshua commanded us to do. You have the ability to become one of the “elect” that Yeshua told you about. One of the ones that will not be deceived in the Last Days, which are here! You will not be timid and passive, but bold like Yeshua Himself. You are capable of recognizing your “**Shepherds**” voice, and wisdom gives you the ability to understand and comprehend Yeshua’s words; “**follow me**”, and do so.

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
