# CALVARY, WHAT REALLY HAPPENED, WHAT YESHUA DID FOR US PART 2 OF 2 SALVATION

In the Torah (Old Testament), the people of faith looked forward to the coming of Yeshua because it was revealed to them in the Torah through Abraham, in Gen. 22. They looked forward to the final sacrifice and the atonement of those who accept Yahveh as their Abba.

In the Renewed Testament, after Calvary, we, in faith, look back at what Yeshua made possible for us with His atonement. We have to look back in faith, whereas the other Believers looked forward.

The previous listed exchanges all together can be summed up in one word, "**SALVATION**". Yeshua made salvation possible for us on the stake. Yeshua made provisions on the stake for salvation, but are all people automatically saved?

When we became "BORN AGAIN" Believers, we were given salvation and a guarantee of eternity, provided we continually walk close to Adonai. Rom. 10:9-10 "That if you confess with your mouth, Yeshua as Messiah and believe in your heart that Yah raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation" When Yeshua died on the stake He made it possible for us to be saved from this world, and made it possible for us to have eternal life. Eternal means "time doesn't apply". Millions of proclaimed Christians today are not born again, even though they honestly think they are. Some have been going to church for many years, thinking that saves them. The writer of Romans here makes it clear that you must "CONFESS WITH YOUR MOUTH" (out-loud), to be saved. Too many people today have never confessed out loud with their mouth, and are NOT SAVED.

We are made up as a "TRIUNE" man. We consist of a "body", a "soul" and a "spirit". When a Believer dies, his body goes back to dust, his "spirit" and "soul" go to the good side of Hades, guided by the Death angel of Yah.

John 5:39-40 "You search the scriptures, because you think that in them you have eternal life: and it is these that bear witness of me: and you are un-willing to come to me, that you may have life" Here Paul is saying; "if you believe by reading the scriptures you are saved, you are mistaken". That is bibliography. You must not worship the Bible, you must worship its contents, "CONFESS WITH YOUR MOUTH" to come to Yah.

John 3:3 "Truly, truly I say to you, unless one is "BORN AGAIN", he cannot see the kingdom of Yah"

**John 3:16** "For Yah so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son, that **whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life**"

Acts 16:31 "Believe in Messiah Yeshua, and you shall be saved, you and your household"

To simplify the exchanges that Yeshua made on the stake for us would be as follows:

Yeshua was **punished** that we might be **forgiven**.

Yeshua was wounded that we might be healed.

Yeshua was made sin with our sinfulness, that we might be made right with His righteousness.

Yeshua died our death that we might receive His life.

Yeshua endured our spiritual poverty that we might share His spiritual abundance.

Yeshua bore our **shame** that we might share His **glory**.

Yeshua endured our rejection that we might have His acceptance with the Father.

Yeshua **poured** Himself out that we may have **direct access** to the Father.

Yeshua was made a **curse** that we might enter into the **blessings**.

At Calvary Yeshua became our substitutionary death (olah) offering. He was our offering of thanksgiving to Yah (minhah). He was our peace offering (shlamim). He was our sin offering (hatat), and our quilt offering (asham).

Yeshua arose on the SEVENTH day of the week, Saturday. It is symbolic of Yahveh's divinity. (Detailed information on the true death and resurrection dates are available in my book called: "Christianity's pagan roots, symbols and holidays")

All wisdom comes from Yah. Paul told the Corinthians what wisdom was; "to us who are being saved it is the power of Yah" to the so-called wise men "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise"

**1Cor 1:18-19** Sin entered through the avenue of the intellect, but salvation comes by the stake that destroys the fallen wisdom. It comes through a genuine acceptance of the message of the stake, for the preaching of "Messiah crucified" is "foolishness" (verse 23) to the wisdom of men.

The Holy Spirit has the only key to Yah's storehouse, and it comes in the shape of the stake.

It is difficult to read about the real suffering of Yeshua on the stake without feeling sick inside. When you realize that Yeshua looked forward to the stake on our behalf, we are overwhelmed with His practical demonstration of love and, hopefully, a personal relation of our unworthiness. How should we then live? I believe that Paul said it best: **Phil. 2:5-11** "Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Messiah Yeshua, who, although He existed in the form of Yah, did not regard equality with Yah a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bondservant, and being made in the likeness of men. And being found in

the appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore also Yah highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Yeshua every knee shall bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth, and under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Yeshua is Messiah, to the glory of Yah the Father"

## WHO REALLY KILLED YESHUA?

Yahveh killed His son Yeshua, no one else did it. Yeshua's death had been planned centuries ahead. All of the Old Testament points to the crucifixion of Yeshua. He had to die to fulfill the necessary blood atonement sacrifice required for all of us to be set free. A sect of the Hebrew population was responsible for the physical death that took place, but it was only because Yah the Father allowed and wanted it to take place, in that fashion. It was Adonai's plan from the beginning and from the time He made the blood covenant with Abraham. Yeshua Himself said in **John 10:18** "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative" and look at what Luke says Luke 18:32-33 "For He will be delivered to the Gentiles, and will be mocked and mistreated and spit upon, and after they have scourged Him, they will kill Him; and the third day He will rise again." Also read Isa. 53:4-6 "smitten by Yah"

Yahveh Himself planned the death of His Son by the people just as He made the heart of the Pharaoh hard back in Exodus when Moses was trying to get the people out of Egypt. Yah planned for this to happen so that the Gentiles could be saved. Rom. 11:24-25 "For if you were cut off from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more shall these who are the natural {branches} be grafted into their own olive tree? For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery, lest you be wise in your own estimation, that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fulness of the Gentiles has come in;" Rom. 11:30 "For just as you once were disobedient to Yah, but now have been shown mercy because of their disobedience."

Most Theologians and Clergy blame the death of Yeshua on the Jewish people and because of that, there has been bitter hatred towards them. The hatred turned into anti-Semitism, which in turn fed the anti-Messiah demon spirit throughout the centuries. This anti-Semitism has not ceased throughout the ages, and exists today in every nation of the world.

As to the people that gathered for Yeshua's trial, they were gathered by the temple crowd who were prosecuting Him. Remember, the trial began sometime after dark. Who would be aware that this trial was even going on? Most people would be at home asleep. Only those notified by the priesthood and temple scribes and Pharisees were present. Do you really think these guys were sympathetic to Yeshua's call and ministry? Of course not! When Pilot offered Barabbas in place of Yeshua, he knew what he was doing. Barabbas was no ordinary criminal. He was a political prisoner who had been fighting against Roman occupation of Israel. Of course they wanted to see him set free, Barabbas was well known.

At Passover two who were despised and rejected were to be sentenced to death. Yeshua the Messiah was despised by the Pharisees (the so-called church leaders), and Barabbas was despised by Rome. "Barabbas" is a contraction of the Hebrew words "bar" meaning "son", and "Abba" meaning "Father", thereby "Barabbas – Son of the Father". Yeshua, selected as the perfect substitute became the atonement offering. Barabbas, deserving death as the Azazel, was released. This is a very clear reminder of the so-called christian church today who has chosen to follow another "son of the father", Barabbas whom they call Jesus Christ. They have chosen another Messiah rather than the Jewish Messiah Yeshua now, as they did back then. It is called rebellion, spiritual rebellion. The Pharisees back then (the CEO'S of the christian churches today), were afraid of loosing their titles and privileges as priests, by allowing the real Messiah to be recognized. This is just like it is to this very day. They want their people to follow their Jesus rather than the real Messiah. If the People ever figure out the Way, they will loose their flock and their income. This is their fear.

Did you ever wonder why thousands of Jews followed Him all over Israel hoping to be touched or healed by Him, but on this night, everyone was saying, apparently with one voice, execute Him? Lumping all Jews into a bad light is anti-Semitism. Not all Jews belong in this category. Read Revelations 6 for confirmation. We cannot say that Jews are not of the true religion, because they are the oracles of true religion of the bible.

This means that the Jews who were there that day and cried out for Barabbas to be released, accepted the blood of an innocent man on their hands. They were politically motivated and were ignorant of what they were doing. Yah will judge them. If Jews are unable to follow Yeshua as Messiah, then I guess that the Apostles, all of whom were Jewish, changed their faith? Show me in the Bible where they did that! They were Jews who believed in a Jewish Messiah, and therefore became completed in their acceptance of Jewish prophecy. Jews are Israel after they accept Yeshua as Messiah. This does not change. Believers are Gentiles who accept Yeshua as Messiah. Believers are the wild olive branches that are grafted into the Tree of Israel, not the other way around. The Bible does not speak of conversion to any other faith except Judaism. When someone accepted the God of the Hebrews in those days, they became a "Ger", or, "proselyte". There is no

Biblical word for a convert to Christianity. Christian was the designation used to tell Gentiles and Jewish believers apart, and "Christian" was, and still is, actually used as a "derogatory term" by the Romans, because it is a slang abusive epithet term deceived people use to stand for Messiah and Believers.

Yeshua was NOT speaking just to the Jewish people in **John 8:44** "You are of {your} father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own {nature;} for he is a liar, and the father of lies." He had been speaking to the Pharisees since verse 13, and He was still speaking to them. "His blood is on us and on our children"? This verse has been used to justify persecution of the Jews through the centuries, by Believers who presumed that the Jewish people had invoked a curse on themselves and on their posterity, and willingly accepted responsibility for "deicide". Yeshua prayed for them because He knew what they were doing to themselves, even if it was out of ignorance. "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Besides, if the Jews were the only ones who killed Yeshua, then He didn't die for anyone else. But He died for all, not just for Jews. The righteous Messiah died for everyone who is unrighteous, that is, for everyone! Everyone, Jew and Gentile alike, is a sinner! By sinning, everyone, Jew and Gentile alike, killed Him! Therefore, everyone, Jew and Gentile alike, is guilty of Yeshua's death!

What Rabbi Yeshua uttered in His agony was not a cry of despair, as is often said, but His last lesson on Earth. He was quoting **Ps. 22:1** "MY Yahveh, my Yahveh, why hast Thou forsaken me? Far from my deliverance are the words of my groaning." By saying that one verse, His Torah-versed audience would immediately remember that Scriptural passage and understand that He was drawing their attention to **Ps. 22:18** "They shared his garments among them." We have not understood this because we have severed ourselves from the cultural container, from Judaism, where Scripture draws from all its content.

Even today if I say to you, "for God so loved" you would know I was quoting from John 3:16 I'm sure. Messiah was teaching from the stake. Yeshua speaking the first lines of Psalm 22 was hinting or pointing to it. This kind of teaching is classified as "Remez". Yeshua Messiah used Remez from the stake. We read when Yeshua cried out in Matt. 27:46 He was teaching them who He was. "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthami? that is to say My Yah, My Yah why hast thou forsaken me?" Right from the stake Yeshua was saying to ALL those who watched, "I AM the One spoken of in Psalms 22, remember my words. It is I hanging here - I AM the One!"

Yeshua was a Great Rabbi to the very end. This was indeed His last attempt to tell them "He was Messiah." However, pride blurred their vision and kept them from seeing the completed Picture.

As per the possibility of grave robbers stealing Yeshua's body, this is highly unlikely. A Roman guard was one of the greatest, strictly disciplined fighting units. A Roman security guard would never fall asleep, as the penalty was death. They rotated shifts every four hours to ensure top performance of duty. It is reasonable to conclude that the Roman guards came to the chief priests out of desperation following Yeshua's resurrection. They feared for their lives, and they knew that the chief priests would have influence on Roman authorities.

### **THEORY**

The following is a theory which I believe to be worth considering, about who was really responsible for Yeshua's death.

The crucifixion plot of Yeshua was organized by the Pharisees, scribes, chief priests, and Caiaphas, the high priest. King Herod (an Igamion, or half breed Jew) was appointed by Rome and set up Caiaphas as a high priest. At the time of Yeshua's crucifixion the temple priesthood had already been corrupted. The High Priests were buying their position as head of the Temple. Caiaphas the High priest bought his position, he was not a holy man (Matt. 26:57).

He had at his finger tips; Caiaphas was Herod's stooge. The Roman leaders were afraid of Yeshua, He was a threat to Rome in many ways. But He was particularly a threat to the army itself, because He could feed multiples of people with only a few loaves of bread. He could heal the sick, and on command, raise the dead. If Yeshua could have been used for military purposes the Roman army didn't have a chance. This man, Yeshua, in fact was a serious threat to the Roman Empire.

In Mark 11:18 it talks about all the people being astonished at Yeshua's teaching. The scribes heard of this teacher and were frightened of him. They instigated a conspiracy to get rid of Him. In Mark 12:12, it says they wanted to grab Him but they feared the multitude of people. Why would they fear the people (the Jews) if the Jews were anxious to kill Yeshua? (Luke 20:19) Yeshua was in fact so popular with the people that they were afraid to arrest Him because of a riot. So, in fact, the Jews loved Yeshua, and would not dare hurt Him. It was a few of the Pharisees that instigated a conspiracy against Yeshua, even though the majority of Jews liked what He was doing.

It seems nobody wants it pointed out, but the fact is, it was the MINISTERS/PREACHERS/SPIRITUAL LEADERS of that time that killed Yeshua. Think about this. It was the high priest and other priests who spit on Yeshua, and hit Him with their fists prior to the crucifixion. (Matt. 26:63-68). The so-called spiritual leaders back

then are like many of our leaders today that know who Yeshua truly is, but don't teach people how to follow Him. They teach people how to follow a particular brand of religion so they can be esteemed. They don't want their flock disturbed with the truth. They want full power and control over their lost sheep, and they want to keep them under their control. If the people learn the truth about Yeshua, they won't need the priests as much, and won't support them financially to the extent they do now.

When Nicodemus (a Pharisee) went to see Yeshua after sundown, it was because he was a judge, and he was extremely busy all that day. He came as soon as he could to talk to Yeshua. Nicodemus didn't hate Yeshua, Nicodemus knew Yeshua was sent from Yah. (John 19: 38-39)

There were three groups of Pharisees, one group loved Yeshua, (Luke 13:31) one group hated Him, and one group were quiet. The Pharisees that followed Halel, hated Yeshua because He put them in their place. (Luke 5:16) The Pharisees of John 9:15 are referred to as Jews. The mob at the mansion of Caiaphas was gathered and controlled by Caiaphas himself. (Matt. 27:20) This mob was made up of Pharisees who hated Yeshua, this group made up only a small percentage of the population. Scholars estimate there were about 1 million Jews at the time of Yeshua. Of this 1 million only about 6,000 were Pharisees. These were the people responsible for Yeshua's death, not the Jews as a whole.

There is another idea that is represented at Calvary. Yeshua/Yah was not only the chief Rabbi of the world, but He was also the bridegroom of the marriage of Israel. One of the reasons Yeshua died was to end the marriage vow of the previous covenant, which ended in Yah divorcing Israel for harlotry (idolatry... Jer. 3:8, Isa. 50). In Jeremiah 3:8 it talks about Yah giving Israel a certificate of divorce. That's what the 70 year Babylonian captivity was all about. Yah pleaded with His people: "return to me and I will return to you". Before a wife can re-marry, her husband must die!

Another misconception; Judas was not an ethnic Jew. Ten of Yeshua's disciples were ethnic and religious Jews. Judas Iscariot and Simon the Canaanite were not ethnic Jews, they were Proselytes. Iscariot was not the last name of Judas, it was "Ish-kirot", "Ish" means man and "kirot" means he was a citizen of the city of Kir, or Kirot, in southern Moab, from across the Dead Sea, (a foreigner). Many scholars believe that Judas was Herods spy from the very beginning. Mary Magdalene was also a Proselyte, she was actually Mary from Migdol.

Anti-Semitism is a demon spirit designed to torment the Jewish people for bringing the word of Yah to the people's of the world. The Jewish people did not kill Yeshua, Roman soldiers did. A small group of Jewish Pharisees were responsible for Yeshua's death. Almost all the Jews loved Him.

In Luke 18:32 Yeshua is handed over to the Gentiles to be killed, not the Jews. Luke 18:32-33 "For He will be delivered to the Gentiles, and will be mocked and mistreated and spit upon, and after they have scourged Him, they will kill Him; and the third day He will rise again."

Mark 15:10-11 "For he was aware that the chief priests had delivered Him up because of envy. But the chief priests stirred up the multitude {to ask} him to release Barabbas for them instead." Many of the chief priests of those days are the same as the envious clergy we have today. They are CEO's taking care of business.

#### THE RESURRECTION

Picture this if you will, after Yeshua rose from the dead He received the keys to Death and Hades from Elohim, and He used them to open up Hades (Rev. 1:18). He then descended into the Abode of the dead under the waters of the earth somewhere (Abyss), He grabbed Satan by the hair and He dragged him through the Abode showing all Satan's Fallen angels just who was in control. He humiliated Satan in front of all of the demon spirits there, and He pronounced clearly that He was the Son of Yah and that He had just whipped Satan. He showed them without a doubt that this sickening thing dragging behind Him was nothing anymore, that from that day forward he was only capable of bluffing his way into the minds of the people. He shamed Satan like His father did many years before, and He reminded all evil spirits and Satan himself that He, and only He, Yeshua, the Son of Yah, was in control from then until the end of eternity!

Where is the Abode of the dead? No one knows for sure, but the following scriptures give us a pretty good idea. **Job 26:5** "The departed spirits tremble **Under the waters** and their inhabitants." **Exod. 20:4** "You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or **on the earth beneath** or in the water under the earth." **Phil. 2:10** "that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of those who are in heaven, and on earth, **and under the earth**."

At Calvary, a divine exchange took place. Included in this exchange was the fact that He bore all our rebellion and all its evil consequences. Yeshua died the last Adam and rose as the second man, the Divine man.

The key to unlocking the treasures of Yah's provisions is this: "all the evil due by justice to us came upon Yeshua that all the good due to Yeshua might be made available to us."

After Yeshua rose on the third day (Saturday), unbelievable things happened in Golgotha, in

Matt. 27:51-53 it explains it "And behold the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom, and the earth shook; and the rocks were split, and the tombs were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection they entered the holy city and appeared to many." This explains how powerful the effects of the resurrection were; that dead people actually arose and walked the streets of Golgotha.

Who Raised Yeshua from the Dead?

Which part of Elohim raised Yeshua from the dead?

Was it the Father, Son or Holy Spirit?

The Father Raised the Son

Rom. 6:4 "Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, in order that as Messiah was raised from the dead through the glory of the **Father**, so we too might walk in newness of life."

**Gal. 1:1** "Paul, an apostle (not {sent} from men, nor through the agency of man, but through Yeshua and **God** the **Father**, who raised Him from the dead),"

The Son Raised Himself

John 2:19 "Yeshua answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." John 10:18 "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father."

Jewish writings tell us that the veil that was hung in the Temple was actually two veils, each one a hand-breadth thick. One was hung on the outside of the door to the Holy of Holies, and the other was hung on the inside, creating a space between them. The High Priest entered on the right side of the outer veil, turned to the left and walked between them to the other end where he entered the Most Holy Place. He exited by retracing his footsteps. After the Temple was destroyed, when the Ark of the Covenant was not present, the blood was sprinkled on the stone that it would have set on.

Matt. 27:52-53 illustrates that by the death of Yeshua people could be brought back to physical existence after death. **Matt. 27:52** "and the tombs were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised;"

Paul compares the resurrection of Messiah to the birth of a child. The resurrection is the birth from the dead. Yeshua was the first fruit of the new God-man nature. He is the head of the church as we now call it. As in a normal birth, the head comes out first, and that guaranties the rest of the body will follow. Hence we again get more typology, another meaning of "follow me" and another look at the meaning of the "Feast of First Fruits".

#### **SUMMARY**

#### When Yeshua presented Himself on the stake He did the following:

Yeshua made provisions on the stake for salvation but are all people automatically saved? Yeshua made provisions on the stake for all our sins to be forgiven. He allowed all the sin that had

taken place up to that time, and all the sin that would ever take place to be forgiven, but have all people automatically accepted this?

Yeshua made provisions on the stake for the healing of our diseases but are all people automatically healed?

Yeshua made provisions on the stake for setting all captives free, but are all people automatically set free?

Yeshua made it possible for all His children to live in abundance, but are all people automatically spiritually prosperous and abundant.

Yeshua made provisions on the stake for the breaking of the curses, but are all curses automatically removed from people?

Yeshua made provisions for all our needs on the stake but **none** of it is automatic, we have to use our authority together with His name to be set free of everything if we follow Him, if we "do as Yeshua did".

Yeshua died so that we could live an eternal life, but it's not automatic. He died so that all our sins could be forgiven, so that all our sicknesses could be healed, so that we could have all our curses removed and so that we could be set free from the devil. We, as Believers represent the Kingdom of Yah, we are to be on the offensive, not the defensive. Yeshua didn't die so that we could be a bunch of timid quiet spoken people. Yeshua always spoke with authority, **He was a "rebel"**. He gave us all the tools needed to win the spiritual war going on all around us, and it is essential that we continue the war against Satan, his principalities, rulers and authorities. You might say that He gave each of us some "talents", what we do with them is up to us, but remember, you will have to account for the talents you received when He comes back. (Matt. 25:14-30)

Yeshua went through an incredible amount of pain for us and yet He still forgave us for His pain. If Yeshua could do this for us, then we should be able to forgive our enemies and bless them, like the scriptures say.

Lions are known for their roars as they pursue their prey. The reason Lions make this blood-curdling sound, is to terrify their prey into making an error as they are being pursued. The Bible says Satan is a roaring lion, but at Calvary, he got his teeth knocked out.

In Luke 9:23 Yeshua said something that most people seem to "daily" forget. "And He was saying to {them} all, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his stake daily, and follow Me."

So what was really done away with at Calvary? I don't believe Yah's immutable, unchanging, perfect, standard for living known as "morality", the law and the Ten Commandments was. Rather it was the laws contained in the ordinances given exclusively to the priests and pertaining to the Temple sacrifices that were done away with at the stake. These ordinances and regulations were complete in Yeshua. These sacrificial laws and the sacrificial system was removed because Yeshua became the perfect lamb of God blood sacrifice, and no more blood sacrifices would be necessary for us to come into Yah's Holy presence. All things in regards to the Levite priests, sacrifices and the sacrificial laws were removed, so all could come before the thrown of grace independently. The veil was torn away from the front of the Holiest of Holies, and we are now allowed to communicate directly with Adonai.

Other notable scriptural passages referring to the stake:

**1John 3:16** "We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren"

**1Cor. 15:3-4** "For I delivered to you as of first importance which I also received, that **Messiah died for our sins according to the scriptures**, and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the scriptures,"

Rom. 5:8-9 "But Yah demonstrates His love toward us, in that while we were yet Sinner's, Messiah died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of Yah through Him."

Acts 20:28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of Yah which He purchased with His own blood."

**Hebr. 9:22** "And according to the law, one may almost say, all things are cleansed with blood, and **without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness**."

**1Pet. 1:18** "Knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, **but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Messiah"** 

**Rev. 1:5** "And from Yeshua, the faithful witness, the first-born of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves us, and **released us from our sins by His blood,**"

John 6:35 Yeshua is the BREAD of life. "Yeshua said to them, "I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me shall not hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst." Yeshua says He "is" the bread. He does not say that He will give us the bread of life. "Bread", in the Bible means "satisfaction". The scripture uses hunger to represent the dissatisfaction of man. Bread means none other than "Yah Himself".

**Col. 3:4** Yeshua is **LIFE**. "When Messiah **who is our life**, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory."

**John 11:25** Yeshua is the **RESURRECTION**: "Yeshua said to her, "I am the **resurrection and the life;** he who believes in Me shall live even if he dies," When Lazarus died, Messiah did not tell Mary and Martha He had the power to raise up their brother; instead He declared that He "is" the resurrection.

**Ps. 27:1** Yeshua is the **LIGHT and SALVATION**. "Adonai is **my light and my salvation**; Whom shall I fear? Adonai is the defence of my life; Whom shall I dread?"

John 14:6 Yeshua is the WAY, the TRUTH and the LIFE. "Yeshua said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me." Yeshua says that He "is" the way. He does not say He will guide us to walk in the way. He says He "is" the truth and life. He doesn't say that He will teach us the truth. Yeshua says that He "is" true life. He doesn't say that He will give us life. What is difficult for us to comprehend is that in the Believer's experience we need only to look for Yeshua, "He is all". It is difficult for most people to understand the significance of this but Yeshua "is" "everything," He is our "all in all". Whatever Yeshua gives is His very own self, the Word, life in the flesh.

Yahveh's Messiah is "everything". Yah has not given us light, He gives Yeshua to us; Yah has not given us food, He gives Yeshua to us; Yah has not given us the way, the truth, and the life, instead He gives us Yeshua. Yeshua is the answer to all things. Yeshua is love. Yeshua is our "all in all". The "law of life" is non other than Yeshua becoming our "life" as well as things. Col. 1:16-20 "For by Him all things were created, {both} in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created by Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the first-born from the dead; so that He Himself might come to have first place in everything. For it was the {Father's} good pleasure for all the

fullness to dwell in Him, and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace **through the blood of His stake;** through Him, {I say}, whether things on earth or things in heaven."

\*In days of old there were cities of refuge for people who ran away from the law. One could stay in these cities of refuge till the High Priest of that time died; then the individual was set free. When Messiah died on the stake we were likewise set free, because He was the High Priest and when He died we were set free.

Jude 4 "For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand marked out for this condemnation, unfaithful persons who turn the grace of the Almighty into **licentiousness** and deny our only Master, Yeshua Messiah". We have lawless Believers today like those Yeshua was talking about in **Mark 7:20-23** "And He said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, **lasciviousness**, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man." Strong's concordance says "licentiousness" means "a license to do as you please". This is exactly what many Christians are doing today, in the name of their Jesus. Many are doing as they please, and getting their ears tickled while doing so in churches (2Tim. 4:3-4).

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
