

THE HEBREW ALPHABET

consists of 22 (2 × 11) letters, so the 5 finals were added to make up three series of 9, or 27 in all:

BIBLE CODES

There are no hidden codes in the bible as many false teachers would have you believe. The bible itself tells us this in the Book of Deuteronomy. **Deut. 31:12-13** "Assemble the people, the men and the women and children and the alien who is in your town, so **that they may hear** and learn and fear Yahveh your Elohim, and be careful to observe all the words of this law. "Their children, who have not known, **will hear and learn** to fear Yahveh your Elohim, as long as you live on the land which you are about to cross the Jordan to possess." You can't hear codes in literature. "**So that they may hear**" speaks volumes. That's why the Torah was supposed to be read out loud publicly every seven years at least (Deut. 31:10-11). So the people could hear it. As per Deut. 17:18, the King himself had to make sure he had a copy of the Torah available to him at all times so he could judge the people righteously as per the laws written in the Torah.
