
CONFESS YOUR SINS TO ONE ANOTHER

When Simon sinned, Peter didn't tell him to confess to a Rabbi, or say ten hail Mary's, he told him to ask Yahveh for forgiveness.

Matt. 27:3-5 "Then when Judas, who had betrayed Him, saw that He had been condemned, he felt remorse and returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." But they said, "What is that to us? See {to that} yourself!" And he threw the pieces of silver into the sanctuary and departed; and he went away and hanged himself."

Many believe the confessional is a duplicate of what the pagans did in their rituals, as they secretly confessed to gain entrance into the mysteries of the Babylonian gods and goddesses. Once received they were bound into the pagan priesthood, and taught the secret meanings behind the symbols and rituals of the mystery religions.
