

SCRIPTURE, WHAT DOES IT MEAN? ALL SCRIPTURE IS INSPIRED BY YAH

2Tim. 3:16-17 ***All Scripture is inspired by Yahveh and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;*** **17 that the man of Yah may be adequate, equipped for every good work.**"

I will very briefly show in the verses that follow that the word scriptures; Grapho, Strong's G#1124 from #1125, is referring to the Old Testament. "Grafo", a verb, means: written, writing, write, describe, described. When we come across the word "scriptures" in our bible we should keep in mind **it is ALWAYS referring to the writings/written word, Tenakh, the Old Testament.** Never will you find otherwise. At the time of the Renewed Testament scrolls the only scriptures/scrolls that were available were the Tenakh, which includes the torah, prophets and writings.



Unfortunately today the doctrine of the commonly called christian churches comes from the Renewed Testament not the Old Testament. This is simply unacceptable and is the cause for so many to be blinded and distracted from the truth. The Old Testament is the only translation we know is accurate and it is the only place you will find Yahveh dictating the Word directly to Moses. Keep this in mind as you read the following verses.

Matt. 21:42 *Yeshua said to them, "Did you never read in the Scriptures, THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED, THIS BECAME THE CHIEF CORNER stone; THIS CAME ABOUT FROM YAHVEH, AND IT IS MARVELOUS IN OUR EYES?"* "Did you never read in the scriptures" is referring to the tenakh.

Matt. 26:54 *"How then will the Scriptures be fulfilled, which say that it must happen this way?"* Referring to the prophets in the scriptures (tenakh).

John 5:39 *"You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; it is these that testify about Me;"* Search the scriptures, the tenakh, it will lead you to eternal life.

2Tim. 3:16 *All Scripture is inspired by Yahveh and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;* Scriptures are good for everything is in reference to the tenakh. This verse is commonly mis-used by most christians in reference to the words of the Renewed Testament. This of course as we can clearly see, is simply not the truth. **The Renewed Testament never existed at the time of these writings, just like the christian church never existed.** If people would understand that one simple fact, it would open so many doors of revelation.

Do christians today put the same value on the scriptures as they did back in the day?

No. The reality is, most christians have been brainwashed to believe that we no longer need the Tenakh (scriptures) to guide us. Hitler himself said that if you tell a lie long enough people will begin to think it is the truth. This lack of reading and studying the word is the reason you see all these churches spiritually stone dead (pun intended). That is why they have become entertainment centres for the congregations. They must entertain the people with music and other drama's to keep their mind off the Word (scriptures) that they know nothing of. They can't teach, so they may as well entertain you while they put their hands in your pockets. If

you can keep people distracted long enough, they will simply forget what they should be doing. This only happens because those sitting in the pews are too lazy to read the Word they claim to represent. It's truly a sad case.

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
