CANADIAN PARLIAMENT/NATION, DEDICATED TO THE OCCULT JAH-BUL-ON GOD OF FREEMASONRY

On Sept 1 1860 construction began on the Canadian Parliament buildings. Thomas Fuller was the





architect of the original Canadian Parliament. He was a Freemason. Thomas Fuller and Prince Albert, (Prince of Whales), also a Freemason, dressed in full Masonic regalia when they presided over the





beginning of construction of the Parliament

Buildings. Both Prince Albert and Fuller exchanged masonic vows, dedicating the entire Nation to the god of Masonry (Jah-bul-on) while lowering the ceremonial cornerstone of the building to the ground. Prince Albert, in doing so, by the authority of the British Commonwealth, cursed the entire Country of Canada. Later on, in 1875 Prince Albert became the Grand Master of the Convent General of the Knights Templar.


The original building was designed just like the Knights Templar church in London in 1185. The original building in Canada burned down in 1916. When you compare the inside area of the Knights Templar church in London with the "Hall of Honor" in the Parliament, you will see they are very similar.

The main Tower of the Parliament grounds had a clock in the center of it. When you take the "Eye of Horus" ("Eye of Providence", "All seeing eye", "Eye of the Great Architect of the Universe"), secret symbol found on the American Seal, and other occult symbols, position it over the clock in the Tower of



the Parliament, you will see the two "eyes" match perfectly, even in respect to angles, and proportions.

On the outside of the Parliament Building you can't miss the occult "gargoyles" protruding from each of the four corners of the Tower. Imagine if you can, any normal human being that would put such occult trash on a building anywhere, never-mind on the Legislative Building representing an entire



Commonwealth Nation. Obviously those in government positions at that time were seriously into witchcraft, just like the Prime Minister Mackenzie King.

William Lyon Mackenzie King (1874–1950) Canada's longest reigning prime minister was a witch, a spiritualist. William Lyon Mackenzie King was born on December 17, 1874, in Berlin (now Kitchener), Ontario. A lawyer and political scientist, he was elected leader of the Liberal Party in 1919 and first became prime minister in 1921. King had contacted Lord Aberdeen himself through table Rappings. King and his close friend Joan Patteson took up the practice of table-rapping at their residences in Ottawa.





They received frequent messages from King's mother, his brother Max, and former prime minister Sir Wilfrid Laurier (1841–1919). In 1936, King went to London to visit the London Spiritualist Alliance. In the 1940s, King continued to consult mediums in England, among them Lilian Bailey (d. 1971), Hester (Travers-Smith) Dowden (1868–1949), Gladys Osborne Leonard (1882–1968), and Geraldine Cummins (1890–1969). In addition to his regular attempts to obtain spirit communication, King had been interested in other aspects of the occult since at least 1918, including interpretation of DREAMS, numerology, synchronicity, and the reading of tea leaves.
