
MAKE NO FALSE OATH

Matt. 5:33-37 (written in red) "Again, you have heard that the ancients were told, 'YOU SHALL NOT MAKE FALSE VOWS, BUT SHALL FULFILL YOUR VOWS TO THE LORD.' (34) "But I say to you, make no oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of Yahveh, (35) or by the earth, for it is the footstool of His feet, or by Jerusalem, for it is THE CITY OF THE GREAT KING. (36) "Nor shall you make an oath by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black. (37) "But let your statement be, 'Yes, yes' [or] 'No, no'; anything beyond these is of evil."



"Make no oath" is another translation error. The proper Hebrew reads: "make no oath falsely". (Refer to Deut. 10:20 and Jer. 12:16) **Lev. 19:12** 'And you shall not swear falsely by My name, so as to profane the name of Yahveh; I am Adonai."
