OUR LOVE FOR YAHVEH..ABBA..FATHER

Matt. 7:21-23 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Adonai, Adonai,' will enter the kingdom of heaven; but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven. "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Adonai, Adonai, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

There are many scriptures that talk about Yah's love for us, but few Believers seem to realize we are to



show Yah how much we love Him. Our good book clearly states (James 2:17) "Faith without works is dead". If we have faith in Yah, then we should have love for our Father, the two go hand in hand. The Bible has many passages about how we are to show LOVE to our Father, but most people simply say "Yah knows what's in my heart". This is true, of course, Adonai does know what's in our heart, but we are to show it outwardly with our obedience to His word. If we don't show it outwardly (publicly), we must be ashamed of our relationship with Hashem. If we are ashamed of our relationship with Him, then we are not worthy of His love, and obviously not worthy to call Him Abba. If you recall, the Ark of the Covenant in the Holy of Holies had gold on the inside and the outside. Our outward actions, spiritual appearance of what we truly feel on the inside, should be apparent on our exterior, and I'm not talking about our clothing. Most people don't seem to realize "LOVE" is a verb.

"active". It simply means that in order for it to exist there must be an "action" of some kind. Webster's Dictionary describes love as: "the reverent affection due from them to God". As our good book makes clear to us throughout, we are to be "doers of the word". This is LOVE for Hashem, our Father. When one follows what He told us to follow, when we are obedient, we become true lovers of Yahveh. When we not only receive His love, but return, it via action, and doing, we show Him we truly adore and love Him. It matters not what mankind says to do. We are to do what Yah tells us to do, according to His living word, not the opinion or recommendation of our many mis-informed clergy. The clergy, teachers, and leaders, who don't tell the people about the importance of following Yah's commandments and laws will have to explain their actions one day to Adonai. In the mean time, millions of deceived Believers are being seriously mislead, and in many cases, it will cost them their salvation. This is because of the improper teaching of those involved, the false prophets in pulpits in SUNday type pagan palaces.



Our Father made it indisputably clear how we are to show Him our love in **John 14:15** "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments." For those who may question their love for Yah, a passage in Matthew is very descriptive. Matt. 7:21-23 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Adonai, Adonai,' will enter the kingdom of heaven; but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven. "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Adonai, Adonai, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?" "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; **DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.**' There are many passages that verify how Adonai wants us to show our love for Him, but they all boil down to what He said from the beginning of time, to Moses. "**KEEP MY COMMANDMENTS**". If we keep His commandments and Laws like He told us, we will receive the blessings, rather then the curses.

Deut. 11:26-28 "See, I am setting before you today a blessing and a curse: the blessing, **if you listen to the commandments of Adonai your Yahveh**, which I am commanding you today; and **the curse, if you do not listen to the commandments of Adonai your Yahveh**, but turn aside from the way which I am commanding you today, by following other gods which you have not known."

Yeshua put it another way throughout the Re-newed Testament when He said: "**FOLLOW ME**". People who claim to be Believers and "talk the talk" without "walking the walk", are not following Messiah. The Believer's life is a Pilgrimage, not a pleasure trip. If a "person of the way" wants Adonai to reveal Himself, then the concept of "GIVE TO RECEIVE" comes into play. By giving love to Hashem He promises to disclose Himself to us. What more can Yah say to us to make us understand the importance of His commandments in our relationship with Him.

In the book of John, Hashem makes it clear how we can receive His revelations.

John 14:21 "He who has My commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves Me; and he who loves Me shall be loved by My Father, and I will love him, and will disclose Myself to him." Do you want Hashem to reveal Himself to you?
