PUNCTUATION ERROR OF THE KJV

Luke 23:43 (written in red) And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise."



The comma is in the wrong place in this verse. Another example of a bad translation. If you put the comma after the word "today" it all makes sense. It should read as follows: "Truly I say to you today, you shall be with Me in Paradise." Because of this error, many have used this verse to back up the foolish theory that we go to Heaven the moment we die. This is not scriptural. We go to Hades after we die, and will be resurrected when Yeshua comes back in the clouds.
