## PAX CHRISTUS

The cross on the helmet of Constantine's soldiers was the same cross that the Jesuits call the "Pax Christus" or "peace of Christ". It is a tall "P" with a large "X" across it in the middle. This cross was commonly used by Nimrod centuries before Constantine. He combined the cross of Tammuz and the cross of Christianity together to make his soldiers all happy, because half of them were steeped in Mithrasism, and the other half in the new pagan Christianity of the early church.





The papal office was produced by a mixture of paganism and Christianity there can be no doubt. The pallium, the fish-head mitre, the Babylonish garments, the mystic keys, the title Ponifex Maximus, were borrowed from paganism. All of these things, and the fact that Yeshua never instituted the office of Pope in His church, plainly show that the Pope is neither the Vicar of Christ nor the successor of the apostle Peter. I believe that the Pope represents the pagan Christianity known today as the Roman Catholic church in place of
