REBELLION IS AS THE SIN OF WITCHCRAFT

1Sam. 15:23 "For **rebellion is as the sin of divination**, And insubordination is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of Adonai, He has also rejected you from {being} king." Spiritual rebellion against the word of Yahveh is as witchcraft.

Some scriptures that pertain to these unclean spirits of witchcraft are:

Isa. 19:3 "Then the spirit of the Egyptians will be demoralized within them; And I will confound their strategy, So that they will resort to idols and ghosts of the dead, And to **mediums and spiritists.**"

Deut. 18:10-12 "There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, one who uses divination, one who practices witchcraft, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, or one who casts a spell, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead. "For whoever does these things is detestable to Adonai; and because of these detestable things Adonai your Yahveh will drive them out before you."

Lev. 20:27 'Now a man or a woman who is a medium or a spiritist shall surely be put to death. They shall be stoned with stones, their bloodguiltiness is upon them.'"

Rev. 21:8 "But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part {will be} in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

1Sam. 15:27 "And as Samuel turned to go, {Saul} seized the edge of his robe, and it tore."

The tzitzit was on the edge/corners of all Jewish men's garments. Samuel's mantle/tallit was made invalid when Saul tore the tzitzit from its corner, because the mantle represented the Word of the Torah, it



meant that Saul no longer followed the Torah. When David later cut off the tzitzit from Saul's robe in the cave, it was symbolic of Saul being made invalid because he wasn't following Torah (1Sam. 24:4 and11). Saul had rejected the Word of Adonai.

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
