
1Kgs. 17:4 THE RAVENS

1Kgs. 17:4 "And it shall be that you shall drink of the brook, and **I have commanded the ravens to provide for you there.**" **1Kgs. 17:6** "And the **ravens** brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he would drink from the brook."



The ravens spoken of here were not birds, they were a tribe of holy people that provided food for Elijah. The Hebrew word "rbm" used here can mean: merchant, Arabians, **or people from a town called Orbo**. The text should actually read as follows: "The Orbim inhabitants of a town in the confines of the Arabs, gave nourishment to Elijah".

When you stop and think about it, it's silly to think that Yah would send unclean Raven's (birds), to provide Elijah, a great Prophet, with clean food, it's just plain silly.
