

## 2Pet. 2:22 A DOG RETURNS TO HIS VOMIT

**2Pet. 2:22** "It has happened to them according to the true proverb, "A dog returns to its own vomit," and, "A sow, after washing, returns to wallowing in the mire."

Peter was talking about so-called believers that had known and experienced some truth. "Dog" here refers to those who were once Gentiles (pagans) who proclaimed to be Believers, turning back to their old ways, not obeying Yah's Torah. "Vomit" refers to the old pagan ways that they put Christian names on as they continued to follow them (pagan holidays such as Christmas, Easter, Valentines Day, New Years, etc.). "Sow" and "mire" are likewise. They followed the easy path of the wide road instead of doing what Yeshua did. There will be much company for those on the road to Hell.

This is thematically connected to **Rev. 22:15** *Left behind* (*Outside*) are the dogs and sorcerers and the immoral persons and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying", The word "outside" here is incorrect. It should read "left behind". "*Left behind* are the dogs and the sorcerers and the immoral persons and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying". Refer back to Rev. 4:21 to be reminded of wormwood.
